This program will provide students with foundational knowledge necessary for a career in TESOL. Students in this program participate in the following activites:

TESOL Methods Course (3 credits)

Students will learn the basics of communicative language teaching, observe EFL classes in Japan, and gain a deeper understanding of English language teaching in the Japanese context.

Classroom observation, field trips, and cultural experiences

Students will observe a variety of EFL classes at multiple levels. Travel to historic and culturally rich locations and hands-on cultural experiences arranged by JCMU are also integrated into the program.

Japanese Culture & Society Course (3 credits)

This course explores the history, values, and behavior of the Japanese people, providing a more holistic view of the country in order to provide context for TESOL course.

Housing is provided in the JCMU Residence Hall apartments.

Requirements	Min. GPA of 2.5; No prior Japanese language study is required.
Program Fee	\$5,000 (tuition, housing, course materials, and health insurance)
